Race Licences

DRIVER-RACE Licences		
Requirements		
Minimum licence required for all national race recognized series.		
First Time Applicants: To qualify for a National licence, the applicant must have held a Regional Licence, have a Racing School Certificate issued by a Professional or driver school recognised by Sports Development Group and have successfully completed at least 6 Regional or Racing School races within the previous 24 months preceding date of application. (One day of observed driving at a racing school, with the Chief Instructors endorsement, may be substituted for one race only) Or, if the applicant holds an GDS National or International Kart licence, has a Racing School		
Certificate issued by a Professional or driver school recognised by GDS (Sports Development Group) and participated in 6 events within the previous 12 months, their application will be considered.		
To Renew: To maintain qualification for a National licence, the driver must compete in at least 1 event requiring a National licence within the previous 24-month period.		
Age Restriction: 16 years and up (date of birthday being binding)		
This licence allows the participation of persons not normally holding competition licences, in certain special purpose competitions which have international entries. The licence is valid only for specific international competitions which must have been individually approved by the FIA as open to Grade D1 licence- holders and indicated as such on the FIA International Calendar.		
This licence is valid only for one competition		
Age Restriction: 16 years and up (date of birthday being binding)		
Licence required for all cars with a Weight/Power ratio greater than 3 kg/hp and for all Club and Bronze International Series registered by the FIA and for all historic cars racing in circuit events (except those mentioned above) regardless of whether some cars have a Weight/Power ratio less than 3 kg/hp. Qualifications for an International D requires participation in a minimum of 5 ASN-sanctioned circuit races for cars within the two years prior to application or hold a FIA Karting International B licence.		
Age Restriction: 16 years and up		
Licence required for all cars with a Weight/Power ratio of between 2 and 3 kg/hp and required for FIA Autocross, Rallycross and Truck Championships. Required also for Historic Formula One cars (Period G onwards), Formula Two cars (Period H onwards), Indy Cars (Period G onwards), Formula 5000 and Formula A cars (all), Group C cars (all), CanAm cars (all), Hill Climb cars in Groups CN, D and E2 of Category II defined in Article 251.1.1 of Appendix J, and Sports Prototypes over 2 litres (Period G onwards) regardless of weight/power ratio.

	First time applicants: To qualify for an International C, applicants must have held either a National Race licence, FIA International D licence, or a CIK International B kart licence and must have completed satisfactorily in at least 5 ASN-sanctioned circuit races for cars, within the two years prior to application. To Renew To maintain qualification for an International C licence, the applicant must participate in at least one international event in a 12-month period. Age Restriction: 16 years and up (the date of the birthday being binding)
International C-H	Valid for historic motorsports events only
	First time Applicants To qualify for an International C-H, applicants must have held either a National Race licence, FIA International D licence, or a International C licence and must have completed satisfactorily in at least 5 ASN-sanctioned circuit races for cars, within the two years prior to application. To Renew To maintain qualification for an International C-H licence, the applicant must participate in at least one international event in a 12-month period
	Age Restriction: 16 years and up (the date of the birthday being binding)
International B	Licence required for all cars with a Weight/Power ratio of between 1 and 2 kg/hp.
	First time Applicants: To qualify for an International B Licence, applicants must have competed satisfactorily in at least 10 national races or international ASN-sanctioned circuit races for cars within the two years prior to application. Or 2) The applicant has held an C licence and has competed satisfactorily in at least 7 national championship or international circuit races.
	Or 3) The applicant has finished among the top three in the final classification of a CIK World Championship or CIK World Cup.
	To Renew: To maintain qualification for an International B licence, the applicant must participate in at least one International competition of the appropriate category per 12-month period. Age Restriction: 16 years and up (date of birthday being binding)
International A	Licence required for all cars with a Weight/Power ration less than or equal to 1 kg/hp
	First time applicants: To qualify for an International A licence, applicants must meet all of the following criteria: • have held an FIA International Grade B licence at the time of application. • have completed in a minimum of 6 events in a Grade C Championship. • have accumulated at least 14 points. The ASN will consider the number of points accumulated in either (a) the three-calendar year period immediately preceding the date of the application, or (b) the two-calendar year period immediately preceding the date of

the application in addition to points accumulated in championships completed in the year of the application, whichever is higher.

• have completed at least 80% of each of two full seasons of any of the Championships listed in Supplement 1 of Appendix L of the FIA International Sport Code.

To Renew:

To maintain qualification for an International A licence, the applicant must participate in at least one international competition of the appropriate category per 12-month period.

Age Restriction: 17 years and up (the date of the birthday being binding)

DRIVER-RALLY Licences		
Category	Requirements	
International R	Licence valid for all "road" competitions (rallies, cross-country rallies, hill-climbs and other competitions in which a separate start is given to each competitor) listed on the FIA international calendar. The Grade R licence is not valid in hill climb for cars in Groups CN, D and E2 of Category II defined in Article 251.1.1 of FIA Appendix J.	
	First time applicants : To qualify for an International R the applicant must have held a CARS National Rally licence and have participated in a minimum of 5 national rallies. Their record must be endorsed by the CARS office.	
	To renew : To maintain the International R licence, the applicant must have participated in at least 1 International event within a 12-month period	
	Age Restriction: 16 years and up (the date of the birthday being binding)	
International R-H	Licence is valid for historic rally events only.	
	First time applicants please contact licensing@asncanada.ca	
	To renew: To maintain the International R-H licence, the applicant must have participated in at least 1 International event within a 12-month period.	
International R-HREG	Licence valid for historic regularity motor sport events only (competitions in which the average speed is 50 km/h max.)	
	First time applicants: please contact licensing@asncanada.ca	
	To renew: To maintain the International R-HREG licence, the applicant must have participated in at least 1 International event within a 12-month period

DRIVER-KART Licences		
Category	Requirements	
National	Licence valid for all National Karting Championships, series and events.	
	First time applicants: To qualify for National Kart licence the applicant must have participated in a minimum of 5 kart races at the club and/or regional level and must have completed a GDS affiliated Club Kart School	
	To renew : To maintain the National Kart licence, the applicant must have participated in at least 1 event within the last 5 years.	
	Age Requirements: please see the Canadian Karting Regulations Book 1: Sporting Regulations for specific Class and age requirements	
International G	Licence is exclusively reserved for Junior categories for International Karting Events.	
	First time applicants: To qualify for the International G, the applicant must have held a National Kart licence andhas competed in a minimum of 5 National Events in the category in which they are participating within two years prior to application.	
	Weight Restriction: must always be a minimum of 35 kg during a competition Age Restriction: Between 12 years old, reaching their 12 th birthday during the calendar year and 14 years of age, reaching their 14 th birthday during the calendar year.	
International F	Licence is exclusively reserved for Senior categories (only non-gearbox categories) for International Karting events.	
	First time applicants: To qualify for the International F, the applicant must have held an International G Karting licence and has competed satisfactorily in at least 5 ASN-sanctioned events in the Junior category within the two years prior.	
	Weight Restriction: must always be a minimum of 40 kg during a competition Age Restriction: Between 14 years old, reaching their 14 th birthday during the calendar year and 15 years of age reaching their 15 th birthday during the calendar year.	
International E	Licence is exclusively reserved for Senior categories for International Karting Events	
	First time applicants: To qualify for the International E, the applicant must have held a National Kart Licence and have competed in a minimum of 5 national events in the category in which they are participating within two years prior to application. Or they must have held an International F or G Karting licence and has competed in a minimum of 5 national/international competitions during the 24 months prior to his application.	
	Age Restriction: 15 th birthday during the calendar year in which the licence is issued. If licence is required for Superkart Drivers, the applicant must be 18 years old or older)
